Maybury State Park Track chair opportunities!

Maybury State Park's track chair program helps provide accessibility to the park's 26 miles of trail experiences and forested areas.

Track chair\guided hikes can be reserved
June 1 – October 31
Saturdays and Sundays
9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
(depending on trail conditions)

Cost

Use of the track chair is free of charge, and is available on a first-come, first-reserved basis. Track chairs were generously donated by Kali's Cure for Paralysis Foundation.

Reservations

The track chair may be reserved by contacting the park office during business hours Monday – Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Volunteer hike escorts

Friends of Maybury volunteers are available to provide guided hikes. Volunteers are knowledgeable about natural features and history at the park. Each hike takes 1 to 1 1/2 hours and utilizes both paved and unpaved trails.

Safety and rules

Service animals are welcome but must be under the control of their handler or a companion at all times. Visitors with pets must adhere to the state park rules regarding pets. Be advised that leashes, long clothing, blankets or other dangling items (i.e. camera straps, etc.) are at risk of becoming entangled in the chair. All track chair users must sign a waiver of liability.

Park entry

The track chair is available at the park headquarters maintenance shop, located off the Beck Road park entrance. Your vehicle may be parked at the shop area. A Recreation Passport is required on all vehicles entering the park. Recreation Passports may be purchased at the Michigan Secretary of State offices or at park entrances.

Transfer options

If assistance is needed to transfer to the track chair, a companion must be able to assist with the transfer. Park staff and/or volunteers are unable to assist with transfers.



What to bring

You may want to bring water, weather-appropriate clothing, a seat cushion, a hat, sunblock, sunglasses, snacks or a camera.
