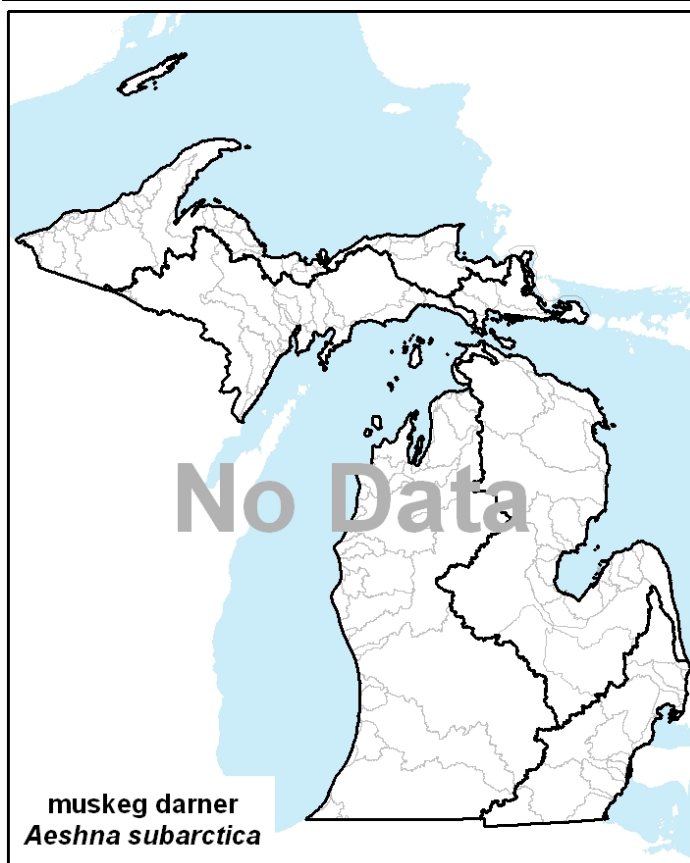


# INSECTS



## muskeg darner

(*Aeshna subarctica*)

**DISTRIBUTION & ABUNDANCE:** Abundance unknown; potentially extirpated from Michigan. Historically has been found on Isle Royale and in Keweenaw, Houghton, Gogebic, and Chippewa counties (no point data available).

**ASSOCIATED LANDSCAPE FEATURES:** ponds; bog; fen; inland emergent wetland; lowland conifer; swamp

**ASSOCIATED THREATS:** lack of scientific knowledge; unknown; wetland modifications

**COMMENTS:** Distribution and population status need to be determined. May not have been found in Michigan since 1900. Edge of range species – typically more common in subarctic areas. Relative severity of listed threats is not well known and other currently unknown threats may exist for this species; a threats assessment is needed for this species.
