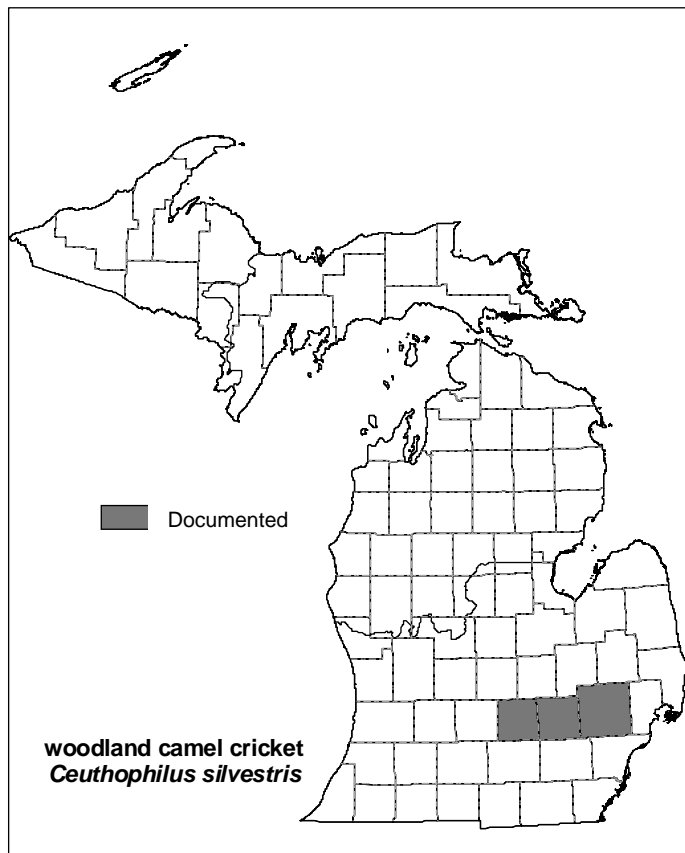


# INSECTS



## woodland camel cricket (*Ceuthophilus silvestris*)

**DISTRIBUTION & ABUNDANCE:** Known from 3 counties in the Southern Lower Peninsula. It is rare in Michigan except in specific habitats. It has a limited distribution; known only from a handful of locations in the Midwest.

**ASSOCIATED LANDSCAPE FEATURES:** idle/old field; fence row; lowland shrub; river/stream/riparian/floodplain corridor; inland rock/cliff/ledge; other (mole tunnels)

**ASSOCIATED THREATS:** lack of scientific knowledge; unknown

**COMMENTS:** Need surveys to assess abundance and distribution; need basic life history information; need to identify threats.
