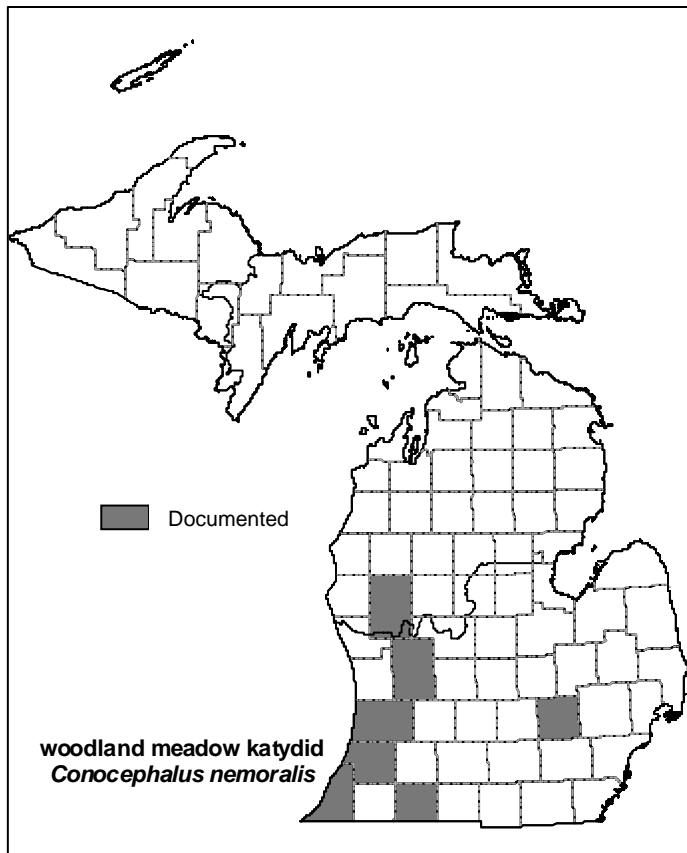


# INSECTS



## woodland meadow katydid (*Conocephalus nemoralis*)

**DISTRIBUTION & ABUNDANCE:** Known from 7 counties in the Southern Lower Peninsula. The specific status of this species in Michigan is currently undetermined, but it is clearly rare in the State. Its status rangewide is also currently undetermined, but it has a limited distribution in the upper Great Lakes region and may be globally imperiled.

**ASSOCIATED LANDSCAPE FEATURES:** idle/old field; fence row; dry hardwood; coastal dune/beach; edge; down woody debris

**ASSOCIATED THREATS:** lack of scientific knowledge; unknown

**COMMENTS:** Need surveys to assess abundance and distribution; need basic life history information; need to identify threats.
