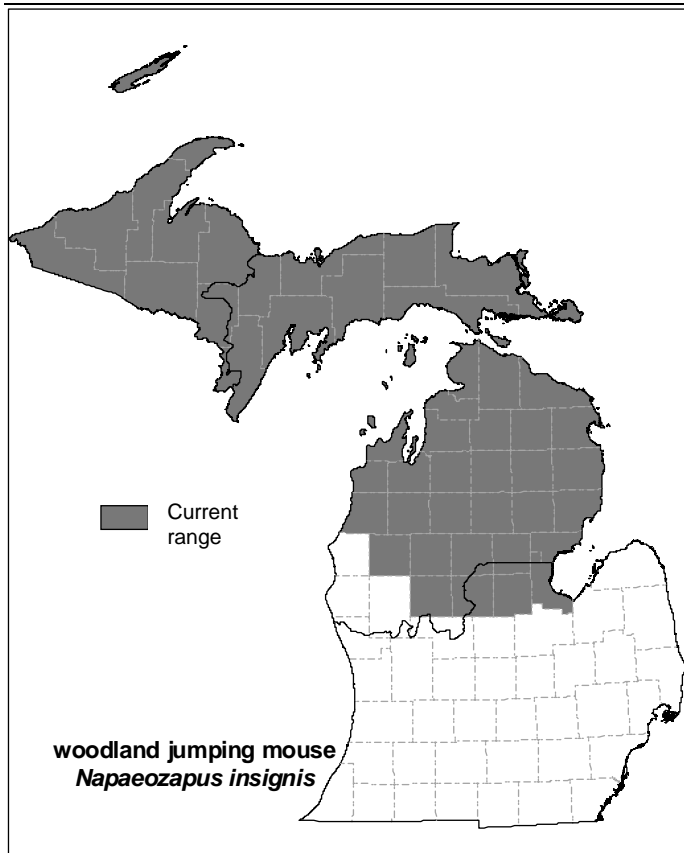

DISTRIBUTION & ABUNDANCE: Woodland jumping mouse abundance across the Upper Peninsula and Northern Lower Peninsula appears to be somewhat low. There is some evidence indicating a decline in abundance.

ASSOCIATED LANDSCAPE FEATURES: lowland shrub; lowland hardwood; mesic hardwood; dry hardwood; lowland conifer; mesic conifer; forest opening; pond; river/stream/riparian/floodplain corridor; inland rock/cliff/ledge; down woody debris

ASSOCIATED THREATS: industrial/residential/recreational development; invasive plants & animals; lack of scientific knowledge

COMMENTS: House cats (including feral cats) may pose a significant threat to this species.
