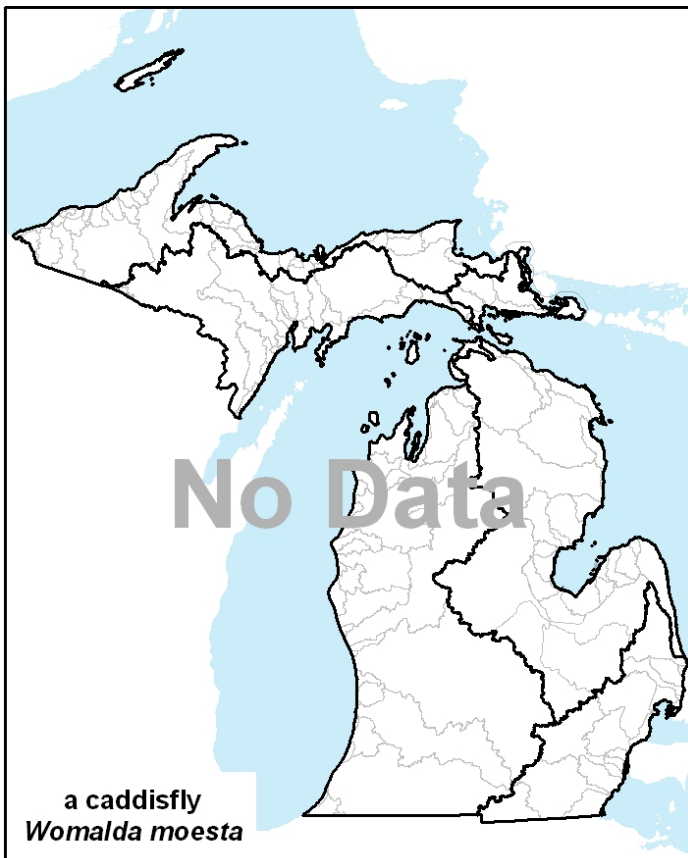


INSECTS – CADDISFLIES



a caddisfly

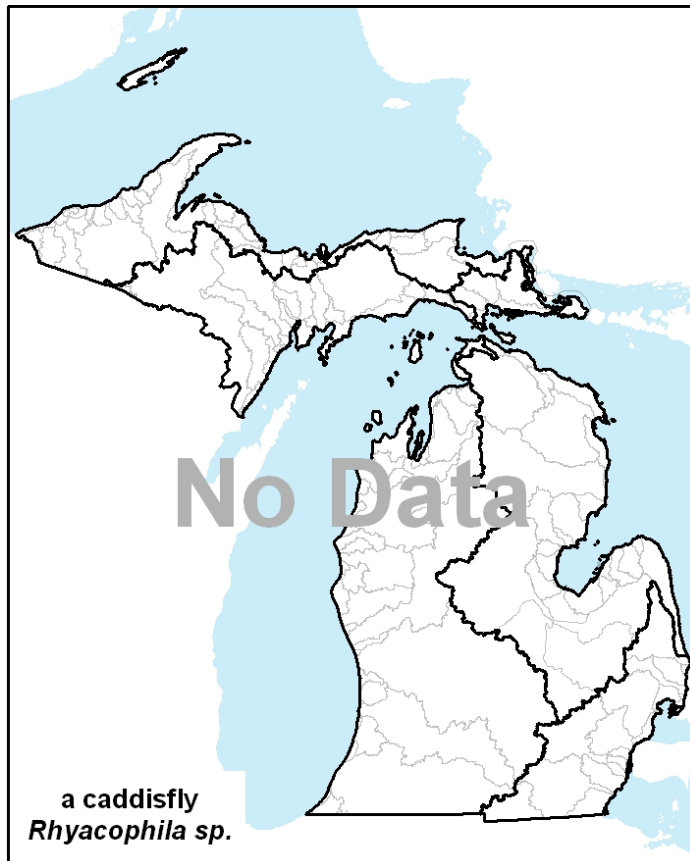
(*Wormaldia moesta*)

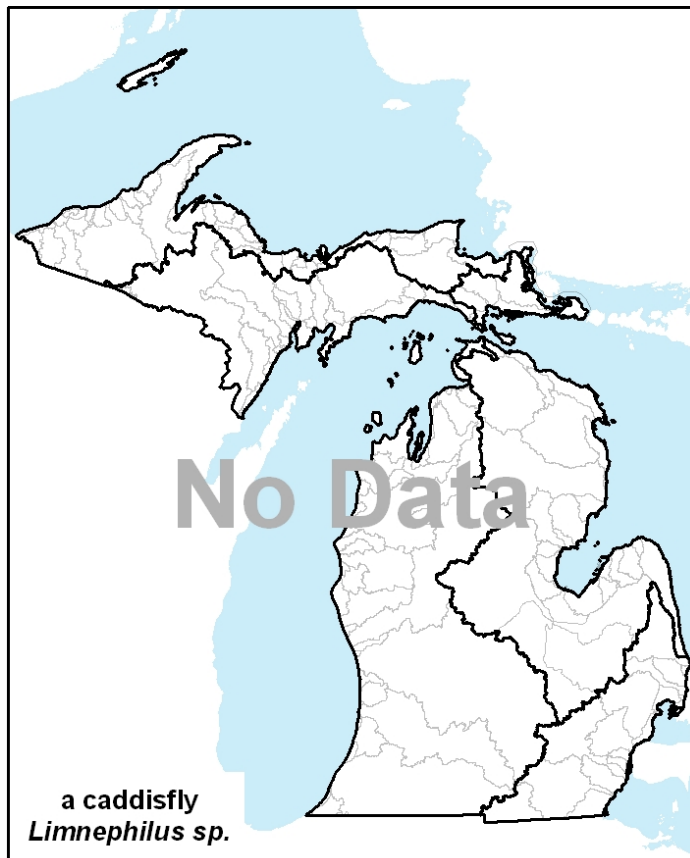
(*Rhyacophila sp.*)

ASSOCIATED LANDSCAPE FEATURES: warm medium rivers; gradient: moderate; gradient: fast; rock substrates; unknown

ASSOCIATED THREATS: lack of scientific knowledge; unknown

COMMENTS: Distribution, population status, habitat usage, threats, and general life history information need to be determined.

(*Limnephilus sp.*)

DISTRIBUTION & ABUNDANCE: Unknown.

ASSOCIATED LANDSCAPE FEATURES: offshore

ASSOCIATED THREATS: lack of scientific knowledge; unknown

COMMENTS: Distribution, population status, habitat usage, threats, and general life history information need to be determined. Species needs to be determined. Found only at Six Fathom Bank in Lake Huron and one place in Canada. These locations are thousands of miles apart. A glacial relict species.

(*Brachycentrus fuliginosus*)

DISTRIBUTION & ABUNDANCE: Unknown.

ASSOCIATED LANDSCAPE FEATURES: headwaters & small tributaries; medium rivers

ASSOCIATED THREATS: lack of scientific knowledge; unknown

COMMENTS: Distribution, population status, habitat usage, threats, and general life history information need to be determined. Larvae have yet to be described.
