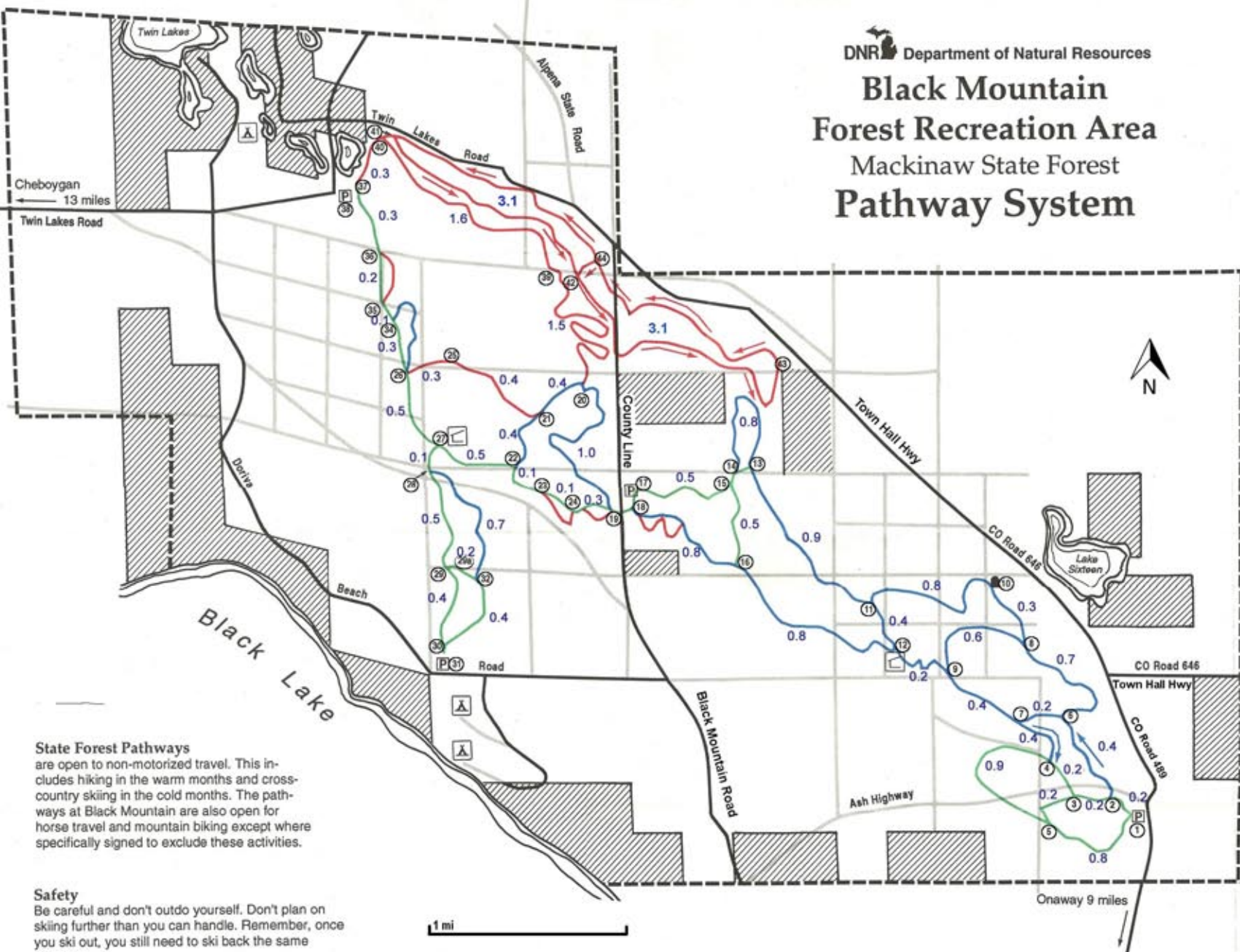

State Forest Pathways
 are open to non-motorized travel. This includes hiking in the warm months and cross-country skiing in the cold months. The pathways at Black Mountain are also open for horse travel and mountain biking except where specifically signed to exclude these activities.

Safety
 Be careful and don't outdo yourself. Don't plan on skiing further than you can handle. Remember, once you ski out, you still need to ski back the same distance. Many hills are steep. Not only do you need to ski down the hills, you also need to do a lot of climbing up.

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
