Cruise Special Instructions:

Species for cruising include hardwood pulp, (including hard and soft maple, yellow birch, cherry, ironwood, ash and white birch), basswood, aspen and softwood. Sawlog trees must be 100% tallied and include sugar maple, mixed hardwood and basswood. The tally sheets may be your own as long as they specify diameter and logs for log tally and trees and sticks per designated species and per plot in the pulp cruise.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets use must be those supplied by the Management Unit.

Special Marking Instructions

Trees must be marked on two opposite sides and try to keep them facing similar directions. (north and south e.g.) The stump marks for all trees marked must be as close to the ground as possible and have a tail that can be seen in winter conditions.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Management Unit.

Restrictions: We wish to be able to identify who did what on our sales. You may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without approval. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

Paint: Call Linda Lindberg to make all paint arrangements. Paint will be supplied from (location) Crystal Falls. Contractors work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply. The DNR will not deliver paint on weekends or evenings.

Deliverables:

1. A list of who marked (cruised) each payment unit (names)
2. A summary of paint used (in quarts)
3. Tally summaries for each payment unit, (one summary regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
4. GPS files for any GPS work done.
