Identified Planning Goals:

Vegetation management in the Cadillac Moraines Management Area (MA) will provide forest products; maintain or enhance wildlife habitat; protect areas of unique threatened, endangered and special concern species; and provide for forest-based recreational uses. Timber management for this 10-year period will focus on harvesting older jack pine and balancing age class distributions of oak, aspen and red pine. Wildlife habitat management objectives include perpetuating early-successional communities for species adapted to young forests for hunting and other wildlife-related recreation. Expected trends within this 10-year planning period are the need to manage exotic species (especially Phragmites and glossy buckthorn), the need to continue to manage cover types for a balanced age-class distribution and an expected increase in recreation pressure.

Soil and topography:

Kalkaska, rubicon sands.

Ownership Patterns, Development, and Land Use in and Around the Compartment:

Four miles west of Moorestown, this compartment is a mixture of private and state land in and around the compartment. Private land has both permanent and seasonal residents. Land use in the compartment is hunting, trapping, snowmobiling and cross-country skiing.

Unique Natural Features:

Potential listings for great blue heron rookery, osprey, eagle, goshawk, red-shouldered hawk, massasauga, wood turtle, and Blanding's turtle.

Archeological, Historical, and Cultural Features:

Special Management Designations or Considerations:

Watershed and Fisheries Considerations:

A number of small unnamed tributaries to the West Branch of the Muskegon River and Haymarsh Creek flow through Compartment 116. The West Branch of the Muskegon River and Haymarsh Creek are both Designated Trout Streams with self-sustaining populations of brook trout.

Wildlife Habitat Considerations:

Featured wildlife species are deer, bear, pileated woodpecker, and ruffed grouse. Management emphasis will be on maintenance of large, contiguous blocks of northern hardwoods for landscape composition, promotion of vertical structure and shrub layer with stands, retention of large diameter trees, and maintenance of aspen and openings. (Victory, 5/24/16)

Mineral Resource and Development Concerns and/or Restrictions

There is no known potential for the occurrence of economic deposits of metallic minerals in this part of the state. The closest known active sand/gravel operation is approximately one mile north of the compartment, and there appears to be some good potential for sand and gravel within the compartment on the uplands. Some past production of hydrocarbons has occurred just north of the compartment, but the nearest active production is more than one mile away, and the nearest active State mineral leases are about one mile away. Multiple drilling permits were issued within the compartment in 2010 but were subsequently terminated and wells were not drilled. There may still be some potential for future oil & gas exploration and/or development within the compartment. The State does not own all the mineral rights within the compartment. Because the mineral estate is the dominant estate, the surface owner must provide the owner of the mineral rights reasonable access to the surface for mineral exploration and development.

Vehicle Access:

A forest road access plan is detailed on the compartment map. Identified are state and county roads as well as forest roads and trails under the jurisdiction of the DNR. Also indicated are forest roads and trails under the jurisdiction of the DNR that are proposed for abandonment. These roads were determined to be in excess of the access needs in the area, are a threat to the resources, or are a concern environmentally.

Survey Needs:

A survey request has been submitted.

Recreational Facilities and Opportunities:

No facilities. Local landowners use the trails throughout the compartment for cross-country skiing and snowmobiling. There are several illegal ski trails on the east side of the compartment. There are no designated recreational trails within this compartment. (T.N. 1/29/16)

Fire Protection:

This compartment primarily hardwoods, with a few small areas of spruce and jack pine. Access would be fairly good for suppression equipment. There are numerous areas of private property, which increases the urban interface concerns.

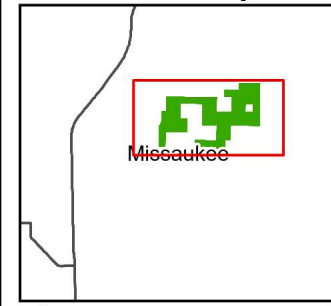

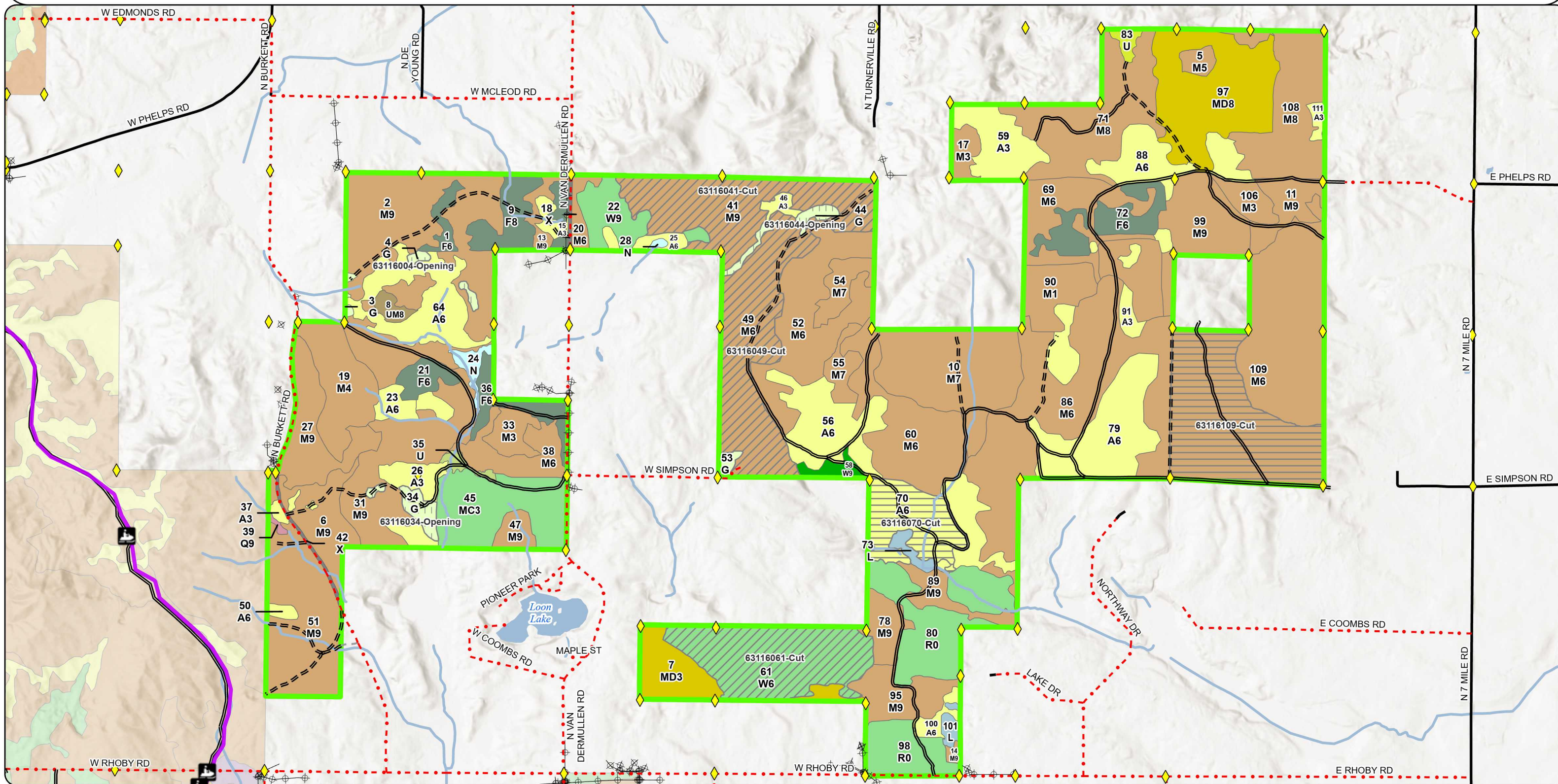

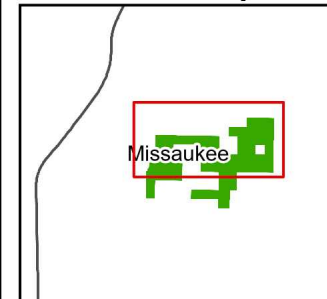

Cover Type & Treatments Map



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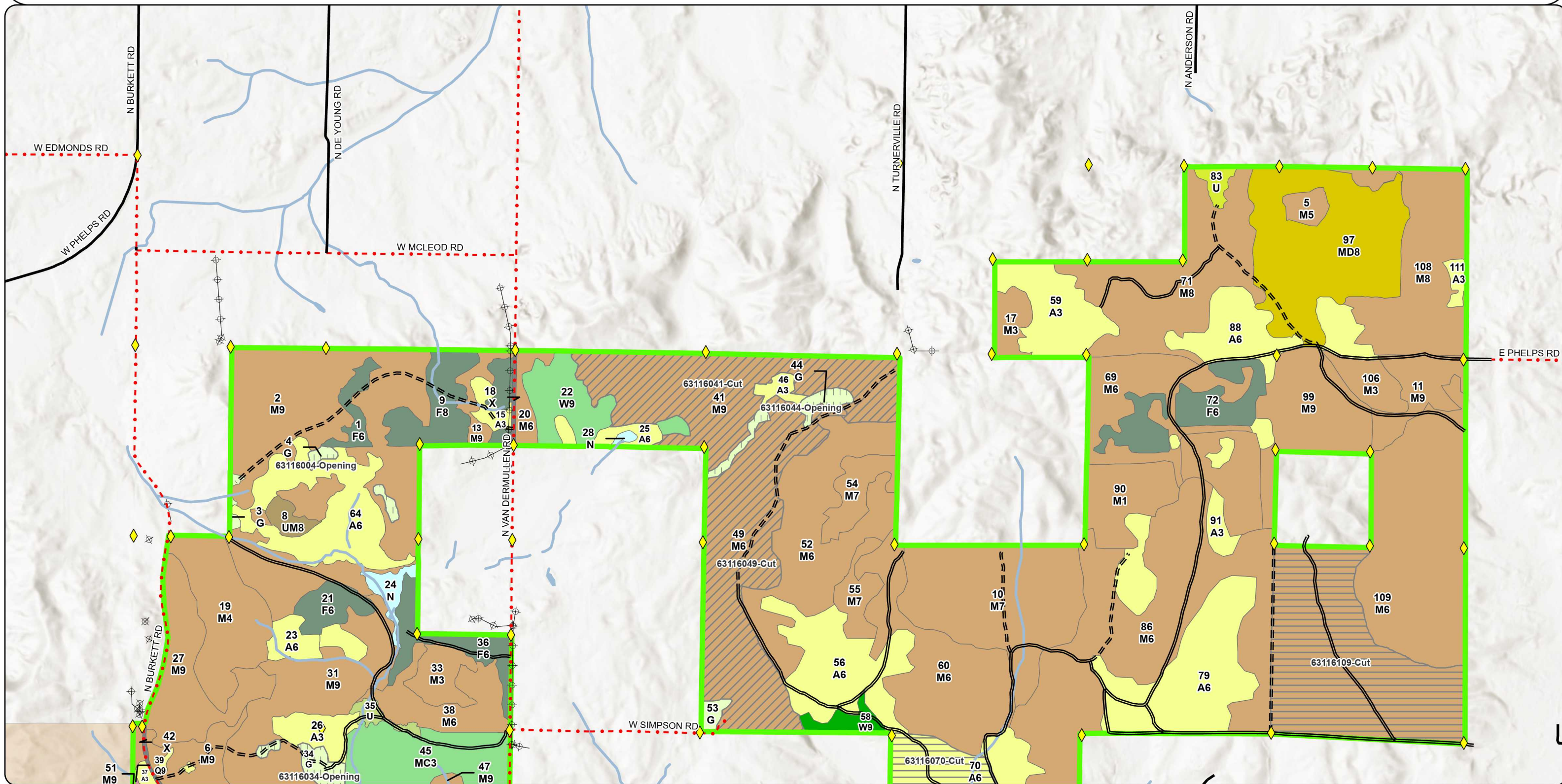
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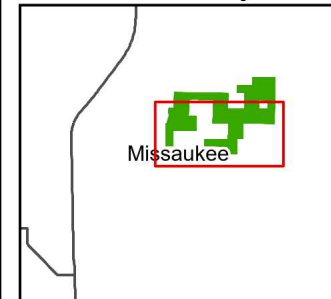

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Stand Boundary Map

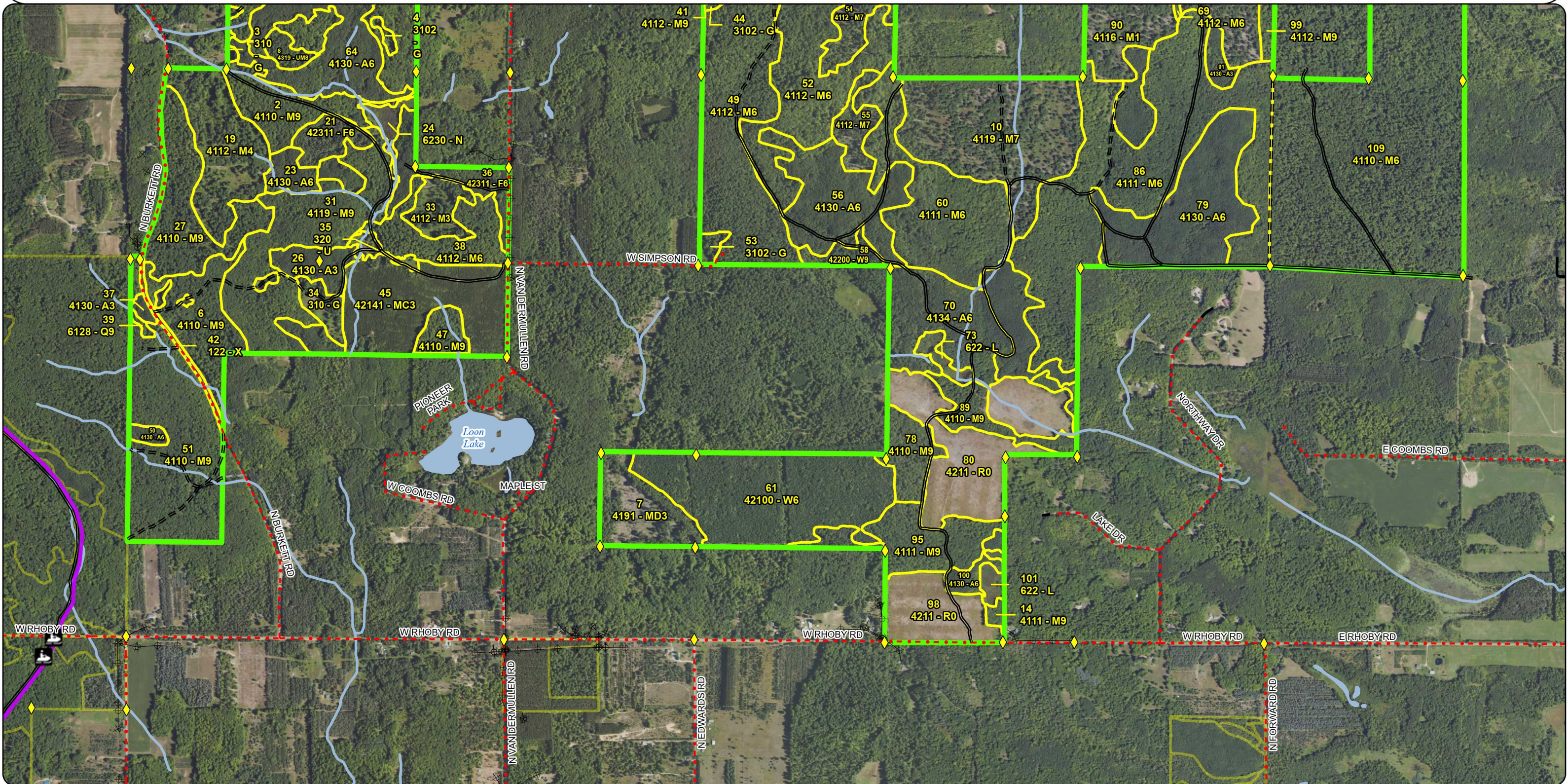


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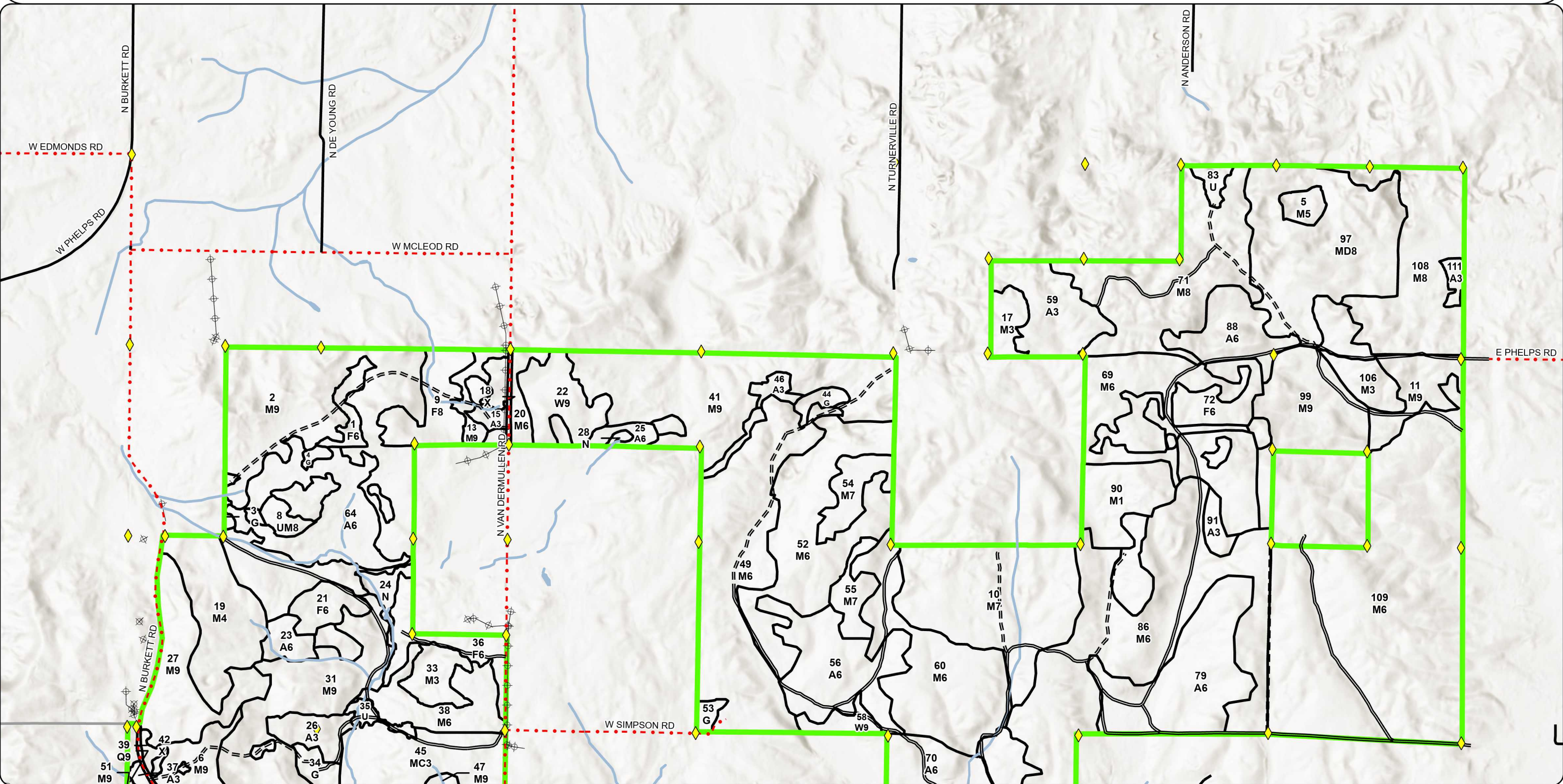
