Identified Planning Goals:

Primary goal is to provide and maintain habitat for the Kirtland Warbler, as a majority of this compartment falls within the core KW area.

Soil and topography:

Soils within the compartment primarily consist of Graycalm, Grayling and Mancelona Sands, with very little variation. Terrain is mostly flat, with a few areas of rolling terrain and higher ridgelines.

Ownership Patterns, Development, and Land Use in and Around the Compartment:

Ownership is primarily state land with a few small private inclusions. Surrounding ownership is mostly state land except for the Northern most boundary, which is federal land. There are also a few larger areas of private ownership adjacent to the compartment within sections 7 and 18 of T24N R02E.

Unique Natural Features:

None known.

Archeological, Historical, and Cultural Features:

There is a known archaeological site within the compartment.

Special Management Designations or Considerations:

Much of the compartment falls within designated Kirtland Warbler habitat.

Watershed and Fisheries Considerations:

None.

Wildlife Habitat Considerations:

Mineral Resource and Development Concerns and/or Restrictions

No known potential exists for economic deposits of metallic minerals in this part of the state. No active sand/gravel operations are known to occur within the vicinity, and while there is some potential for sand & gravel development on the uplands, the compartment might be too far from populated areas (commercial markets) to have much economic value beyond use by the county road commission or DNR for local road maintenance. Oil & gas production from the Rose City field is occurring in the southwest end of the compartment, and some State-owned mineral rights remain under lease and held by production. The field is very mature and other parts have undergone secondary recovery operations. Potential for further expansion of the fields is low. There has been no recent well permitting activity around the compartment. Potential for future oil & gas development within the compartment is considered low at this time. The State does not own all the mineral rights within the compartment. Because the mineral estate is the dominant estate, the surface owner must provide the owner of the mineral rights reasonable access to the surface for mineral exploration and development.

Vehicle Access:

Vehicle access within the compartment is mostly good, with well traveled county roads in Fairview road and Perry Holt rd. There also is a one by one mile grid network of minor county roads that cover the area. These are primarily unmaintained and can be difficult access due to being mostly blow sand material. There are also many state forest roads and two tracks throughout the area.

Survey Needs:

None at this time.

Recreational Facilities and Opportunities:

The snowmobile trail and an atv trail run through and adjacent to the compartment. The county road network also sees a fair amount of orv use and other vehicle traffic. This area is also popular among deer hunters, with several well used dispersed camping areas.
