T27N R5W Sections 30 and 31; T27N R6W Sections 25, 26 and 36

Identified Planning Goals:

This compartment is part of the Kalkaska Sandy Moraines. Management goals for this MA include balancing the age classes of aspen on suitable sites, thinning northern hardwoods, balancing age classes of red pine and Jack pine, and regenerating the aging swamp hardwood and conifer resource. Management will strive to sustainably produce various timber products, enhance game and non-game wildlife habitat, protect areas of unique character, and provide for forest-based recreational uses. Management challenges include maintaining wildlife openings given the logistical and funding challenges that make prescribed burning increasingly hard to accomplish, regenerating certain species, especially in wet areas, in the context of elevated deer browse levels, increased recreational pressure, and introduced pests and diseases.

Soil and topography:

The compartment is mostly sandy soils including Kalkaska sand, Island Lake sand, Rubicon and Lindquist. There are lesser amounts of mucks or loamy soils along the drainages. The central part of the compartment has some moderately hilly terrain.

Ownership Patterns, Development, and Land Use in and Around the Compartment:

Since the last inventory, the State acquired the Flowing Well property and 120 acres in Section 26 were added to this compartment. The east side of the compartment is adjacent to the Black River Conservation Association, a relatively large ownership which also practices active forest management. There are a couple of small inholdings including a 40-acre parcel with a township gravel pit and a small, seasonal subdivision on Johnson Lake. The rest of the compartment is bounded by a mix of private and state ownership. There is a large natural gas pipeline running along Sunset Trail.

Unique Natural Features:

MNFI has designated part of Section 26 adjacent to the Flowing Well acquisition as a Rich Conifer Swamp natural community.

Archeological, Historical, and Cultural Features:

Several old railroad grades traverse the compartment. Johnson Lake Road now follows part of an old route. There is a record of an archaeological site in Section 25.

Special Management Designations or Considerations:

See next section for comments about natural rivers.

Watershed and Fisheries Considerations:

The North Branch of the Manistee is a designated High Priority Trout Stream. The North Branch and other unnamed tributaries in Section 26 are protected as natural rivers under the Upper Manistee River Natural River Plan.

Wildlife Habitat Considerations:

Much of this compartment falls on a broad, flat outwash plain (LTA 5149) characterized by poorly drained peat and muck soils. Habitat types found on these wet soils include mixed lowland conifers, lowland hardwoods, and lowland brush. The North Branch of the Manistee River and unnamed tributaries to Morrison and Black creeks flow through the compartment and add important riparian components to the area. Part of the Flowing Well and Black Creek deer yards are found here. Care should be taken to maintain the integrity of this winter thermal cover.

Excessively drained sandy soils are found as part of large irregular ice contact ridges (LTA 3211) in the northeast and as part of a pitted outwash plain (LTA5211) in the northwest part of the compartment. The more varied topographic relief and sandy and sandy-loam soils support aspen, pine, and northern hardwood stands. This mix of upland habitat types adjacent to large swamp complexes provides benefits to wildlife by increasing the amount of edge between upland and lowland communities. Edge helps to increase species diversity by offering resources from differing habitat types in close proximity. Maintaining a diversity of age classes among aspen stands will add age and structural diversity while increasing habitat suitability for white-tailed deer, ruffed grouse, woodcock, and a variety of other game and non-game species. Some other wildlife species using this habitat mix include bobcat, black bear, coyote, snowshoe hare, raven, alder flycatcher, Eastern

milk snake, and wood turtle.

Non-forested upland openings dominated by grasses, forbs, shrubs, and poorly stocked trees are distributed widely across the compartment. Management of these stands will include prescribed burning and mechanical control of bracken fern. The appropriate use of fire in grassland ecosystems kills encroaching hardwood species, prevents or slows the establishment of some invasive plants, and returns nutrients to the soil. Wildlife species benefiting from maintaining openings in this compartment include white-tailed deer, meadow vole, wild turkey, Eastern meadowlark, and garter snake.

Mineral Resource and Development Concerns and/or Restrictions

There is no known potential for the occurrence of economic deposits of metallic minerals in this part of the state. No active sand/gravel operations are known to occur in the area. There appears to be potential for production of sand within the east half of the compartment on the uplands. The compartment is south and outside of the Silurian reef and Antrim Shale hydrocarbon plays. The operating unit for the Collingwood Excelsior Field, which consists of long horizontal wells transecting the compartment from south to north, covers a portion of the compartment, though the well surface hole falls outside the compartment. This development was completed in 2011-2012, as part of testing of the Collingwood Formation, and while these wells continue to produce some hydrocarbons (primarily natural gas), the formation has not proven to be an economical hydrocarbon play to date, and there has been minimal interest in further development of the Collingwood the past ten years. The mineral rights associated with this unit are held by production. All other State-owned mineral rights in the compartment and the surrounding area were leased in 2023 by Lambda Energy. Lambda's potential interest in the area is not known at this time. There has been no recent well permit activity in the area.

Vehicle Access:

The compartment has relatively good vehicle access. There are three county roads: Sunset Trail (open year-round), Flowing Well Road (open year-round) and Johnson Lake Road (seasonal but plowed to Johnson Lake by residents). In the northeast part of Section 36, there is a poor dirt road which follows an old grade through some very wet stands. This road was not properly constructed for this situation and should be closed until it is needed for timber management and can be properly rebuilt.

Survey Needs:

The northeast corner of the Excelsior Township forty might need to be placed.

Recreational Facilities and Opportunities:

The Kalkaska 50-inch ORV Trail, Kalkaska ORV Route, and Snowmobile Trail #76 run north/south through this compartment. Trail protection specifications should be considered if timber management treatments impact any of these trails. (T.N. 1/26/16)

Fire Protection:

Based on cover types in this compartment, there is little risk of a major wildfire.
