A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Corner established by William Burt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor on June 14, 1848. Set Ironwood Post.

ORIGINAL BEARING TREES:

Lynn 15" S25°W 18 links (16.50 feet)
 Sugar 10" N45°E 43 links (28.38 feet)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. A fence line and plantation line runs North from the corner location. The plantation was planted by a former Forester, the late Donald Fisher, about 40 years ago. a gravel road runs East & West from the same location. An original call to the center of a 2 acre pond East was in agreement. A 6" Maple, 24 feet South of the corner location had an old blaze facing the corner location. I re-established the corner at the centerline of the East-West Road and opposite the fence line running North. This location was in agreement with the called distance to the Section Corners, East and West. I set a monument described in "C" below. C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner location I set a 3/4"x15" long aluminum rod with a 3 1/4" cap stamped to read: T49N R42W, 1/4, S.29, S.32, 1885, P.S. 17610. Monument is 4" below gravel surface. I established the following bearing trees and reference objects:

5" Maple S65°W 47.25 feet - Reference Monument, South 21.80 feet
 4" Maple S24°E 37.32 feet - Steel Sign Post 1.35 feet South of
 Power Pole N42°W 47.02 feet Reference Monument
